CISC Architectural Student Design Competition Submission Criteria

Online Project Submission

To make a submission, go to the CISC website (www.cisc-icca.ca) and under the Education and Research navigation bar, select Architectural Student Design Competition Submission. Simply complete the registration form and then upload a single project file. A sample of the mandatory registration information that will be requested is listed in the attached form.

All entries must be received by the CISC by 5:00 p.m., EST on the date set out in the Competition Poster as the deadline for submission.

Presentation Format

The submission is not to contain more than <u>three</u> art boards of size A1 in landscape orientation in a single project file. The project file must be a press quality PDF file with fonts included and generated directly from the graphic design software so as to retain the vector graphics. Embedded images must not be less than 300 dpi at full scale. Do not include any printer's marks or security protection or restrictions. Any other type of presentation will be disqualified.

The names of student participants, their schools, and faculty sponsors must <u>not</u> appear on the art boards.

Submissions become the property of the CISC, and will not be returned. By submitting an entry, the participant gives CISC the right to display, reproduce or print presentations with credit given to the participants.

Required Presentation Elements

All drawings, photographs, or computer-generated images should be at a scale appropriate to the design solution, and include a graphic scale and compass direction. Each presentation must directly address the specific criteria outlined in the Design Challenge.

Presentations must include at least the following:

- ground floor/site plan
- elevations & sections showing major elements and site context
- one three-dimensional image
- details, drawn at a larger scale (sufficient to explain the use of structural steel)

Judging

The initial judging will be done individually and online using the project files. Using a standardized scoring system, the top ten finalists will be selected. The top ten entries will then be printed by CISC on A1 poster boards and the judges will meet in person to select the Award of Excellence and Awards of Merit winners.

Summary Publication & Exhibit

All winners and other selected projects will be illustrated in detail on the CISC website (http://www.cisc-icca.ca/education) following the adjudication. The top ten finalists will be displayed at various CISC Regional Design Award events and participating schools of architecture in Canada for one year.
