

WHO IS CISC? Award Categories

Who is CISC?

The Canadian Institute of Steel Construction (CISC) is the national industry organization representing the structural steel, open web steel joist and steel platework fabricating industries. CISC formed in 1930 is a non-profit industry association. CISC operates as a technical, marketing and government relations organization that promotes good design and safety, as well as the efficient, economical and sustainable use of structural steel.

Events such as the CISC BC Region Steel Design Awards of Excellence create networking opportunities for architects, engineers, building official, contractors and other stakeholders in the fabrication industry.

Architectural

Steel Buildings or structures in which architectural considerations predominantly influence the design, particularly those with exposed steelwork. (All building types and bridges.)

Engineering

Steel structures in which engineering considerations and the efficient use of steel in unique applications are the predominant factor. (All building types and bridges.)

Sustainability

Steel structure in which steel has been used or reused as part of a sustainable development project that aims to improve environmental impact of the structure by using innovative practices, standards and technologies.

Project Submission Deadline: April 11, 2013

SUBMISSION PROCESS

An "Intention to Submit" form is to be completed online and submitted by March 7, 2013.

Submission Guidelines

A brief written description which shall include a discussion of factors considered and reasons why the steel solution was selected.

Photographs

At least five high resolution (300 dpi) electronic images in jpeg format of the finished product and PowerPoint images on CD. Also include the names of individuals or firms to be credited with the images.

Awards

The awards ceremony is an evening celebration recognizing the design innovation and excellence in British Columbia's steel construction industry. The CISC BC Region Steel Design Awards of Excellence will take place May 23, 2013 at The Fairmont Waterfront Hotel. All participants in the Steel Design Awards competition will be invited to attend.

At the Reception, the Owner, Architect, Structural Engineer, General Contractor, CISC BC Steel Fabricator, Steel Detailer and Steel Erector will each be presented with a memento commemorating the Award.

Eligibility

- ✓ All project entries must be fabricated or detailed by a CISC BC Region Fabricator or Detailer Member and completed between January 1, 2010 and December 31, 2012.
- ☑ Projects must illustrate ingenuity and innovation in the use of structural steel or platework.
- Only one project will be selected from each category for an award (judges may cite one or two projects for Honourable Mention).
- ☑ Project entries outside BC will be accepted.
